The MACA Promise

California will stop managing homelessness and start solving it: shelter tonight, treatment immediately, housing permanently, jobs and family stability, with public safety and county accountability.

Announcement Message

Today I am announcing the MACA Homelessness Cure Mission: no Californian abandoned on the street, no family pushed into homelessness by the affordability crisis, and no neighborhood left unsafe. Compassion, accountability, and results must work together.

Simple Seven-Point Plan

#	Point	Action
1	Shelter First, Safety First	Expand clean emergency beds, women-first safe beds, family shelter, youth shelter, transitional housing, and drug-free recovery beds.
2	Treatment on Demand	Connect outreach, Medi-Cal, hospitals, counties, behavioral health, trauma care, mobile health teams, and recovery beds.
3	Permanent Housing Pipeline	Every interim placement must have an exit plan: supportive housing, rapid rehousing, employment-supported housing, family reunification where safe, or long-term care.
4	Affordability and Eviction Prevention	Audit post-COVID rent, mortgages, insurance, wages, evictions, vacancies, construction costs, and investor ownership to stop preventable homelessness.
5	Resident-First Anti-Speculation	Advance lawful protections against foreign, absentee, and corporate speculative home acquisition and strengthen ownership transparency.
6	Jobs, Food, and Farm-to-Shelter Recovery	Use agriculture, reliable water, fresh meals, food processing, logistics, and workforce pathways to rebuild stability and dignity.
7	3% Homelessness Stability Investment	Propose a 3% state-budget commitment for shelter, housing, treatment, prevention, women and family safety, and county-by-county accountability.

First 100 Days: How We Fix the Crisis

- **Submit the 3% Homelessness Stability Investment Plan** with county implementation targets.
- **Order the statewide affordability audit** covering rent, mortgages, insurance, evictions, wages, vacancies, and investor ownership.
- **Draft the Resident-First Housing and Anti-Speculation Act** within lawful state authority.
- **Expand shelters, treatment, farm-to-shelter meals, and workforce pathways** while protecting parks, schools, small businesses, women, children, and public safety.
