- 1. Safe shelter for every woman.** MACA will expand emergency shelter, transitional housing, and secure beds so no woman in crisis is forced to sleep on the street while searching for help.
- 2. No woman left alone in danger.** MACA will strengthen rapid-response help lines, local outreach teams, and county coordination so women facing abuse, homelessness, or abandonment can reach real support quickly.
- 3. Protect mothers and children.** MACA will support mothers with housing stability, child care access, health care, and family services so women can protect their children and build safe homes with dignity.
- 4. Stronger safety and justice.** MACA will fight domestic violence, trafficking, harassment, and repeat violent crime against women by backing enforcement, survivor protection, restraining-order support, and safe recovery services.
- 5. Jobs, training, and economic power.** MACA will help women move forward through job training, apprenticeship access, small-business support, and return-to-work pathways so women can earn, lead, and stand on their own feet.
- 6. Health and healing for women.** MACA will improve women's health care, mental health care, maternal services, and trauma recovery so every woman can receive treatment, counseling, and long-term support close to home.
- 7. Statewide accountability in every county.** MACA will require measurable county action on shelter, safety, services, and outcomes so women in rural, suburban, and urban California all receive the same standard of care and protection.
